

CDC Performance Company (CDCPC) Requirements

The information below is based on the 2017-2018 dance year. There will be some minimal changes for the 2018-2019 dance year, including a new payment structure to include all dues and fees. These changes will be reflected in the final contract.

Please initial beside each item to acknowledge that you have read and understand each requirement listed below. Thank you!

- ___ Dues for Carolina Civic Ballet, Carolina Groove, Carolina Rhythm companies were \$200 in 2017-2018. Dues for CGE were \$185.
- ___ All dancers are expected to attend their regularly scheduled classes in addition to all rehearsals and performances.
- ___ All dancers are expected to attend summer training either at CDC and/or with an Artist Director approved dance program.
- ___ Participation in the Guest Artist Intensive (presented by Carolina Dance Foundation on August 6-10, 2018) is mandatory for **all** company members, with the exception of those who are **ONLY** in tap company. Dancers who are in academic school this week may submit a request to be excused from this intensive.
- ___ All members must meet fundraising requirement by either participation in fundraising activities or taking advantage of the “buy out” option. Fundraising requirements will be outlined in the final contract.
- ___ Each family is required to sell 6 tickets to the Winter CDCPC stage performance.
- ___ Each family is required to sell 6 tickets to the Spring CDCPC stage performance.
- ___ Each family must volunteer a minimum of 10 hours per season, with an additional 5 hours for each successive company in which their dancer participates. ** Should you not be able to contribute the time, you may opt out at \$20.00/hour.**

Carolina Civic Ballet Members:

- ___ Participation in UNCSA’s Annual Festival of North Carolina Dance, in Winston-Salem, in February for select Carolina Civic Ballet members (ages 11+).
- ___ Participate in at least one of the summer program auditions hosted at Carolina Dance Center.

Carolina Groove Members:

- ___ Participation in 2-3 master class series at CDC is required for Carolina Groove members.

Carolina Rhythm Members:

- ___ Participation in 1-2 tap workshops is required for Carolina Rhythm members. Additional details available soon.

Carolina Groove Elite Members (CGE):

- ___ Must be a member of Carolina Groove.
- ___ Participation in 3 conference workshops/competitions is required for CGE members.
